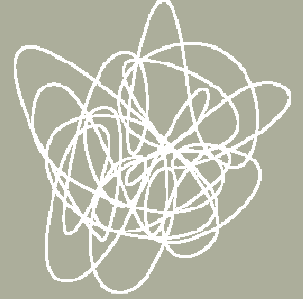

Austria

You do not have to speak more than a little German to become an aupair in Austria.

Use your love of children to open a world of travel. Aupair in the “fairytale” country – beautiful green forests, tall glaciers, amazing skiing, fine food, fine music. Step back in time to romantic Vienna and Salzburg. Quaint city living, easy access to the rest of Europe and great beer!

Age group: 19 - 26 but you may be turning 27 during the aupair year. Single.

Education: Completed year 10 or higher

Childcare Experience: Minimum experience is 50 hours of childcare but 200 hours is preferred. Qualified or well experienced applicants are welcome on this program. There is a demand for qualified or well experienced aupairs.

Period of commitment: 6 and 12 month placement **all year round**.

Summer aupair placement: mid June to mid September **ONLY**. Applications open in October and close end of March

Visa: 6 or 12 month Work Permit. Holders of a European Union passport are not subject to any visa conditions but do have to register with the Austrian authorities.

Applicants to Austria should speak **English well** as families want their children to learn to speak English.

All positions are live in. All salaries are quoted net of tax unless advised otherwise

You pay for your own return airfare and travel/health insurance cover.

AUPAIR

- Work about 25 hours per week
- Care of children plus light housework.
- Babysit for 1-2 evenings
- Be a non smoker
- Preferably have a valid driving license
- Be willing to go to classes to learn German
- Be willing and able to adapt to another culture
- Have a good sense of responsibility and a positive attitude

YOU GET

- Your own comfortable room, shared or own bathroom
- Full board and lodge
- Minimum of 1.5 days free per week.
- Earn Euro 450 per month net.
- 2.5 weeks paid holiday per 6 months of stay
- The family contributes **half** the cost of the German language course.
- Full back up and support from JCR's associate
- Telephone numbers of other aupairs

To be granted a work permit you must be able to show proof of being able to understand and speak Germany to level 1A. This can be done by attending a 3 month German language course in your home country thereby obtaining a certificate showing that you have studied to this level. A copy of the certificate must be sent in with your application.

You may have studied German at secondary or tertiary level education, if so, send proof with application.

You may have been an exchange student in Germany or have learned German in your family. If so, we suggest that you write the family letter in both English and German.

The above requirement is not applicable to summer aupair.

The application for a work permit is a slow one. It can take up to 8 weeks before we receive the necessary documentation from Austria so that you can apply to the Austrian Consulate for your work permit and permission to enter Austria to be an aupair. It is best to apply for this country at least **5 months** in advance of when you would like to go.

WHAT ARE THE COSTS

Commitment Fee:

\$200 paid to RESTLESS when completing the pre-application form

Placement Fee:

\$950 on placement with a family, paid to JCR

If your complete application reaches JCR offices by the date JCR specifies when you start an application, you will be in line for the JCR "Early Bird" discount of \$100 off the placement fee and pay only \$850.
