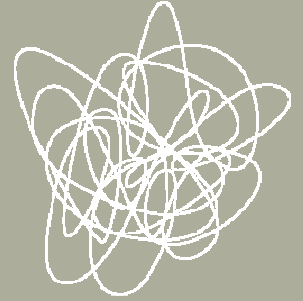

China

China is a country which has an ancient culture in art, food, architecture, Chinese medicine.

There are wonderful festivals throughout the year. There are many cultures and ethnic groups of peoples. It is a fascinating country to live in for a while to absorb the culture and learn something of the language. JCR offers you the chance to AUPAIR for a family in CHINA.

There is always a demand for aupairs and those with a qualification are highly valued.

Age Group: 18-30. Single Males and Females

Groups of 2, 3 or 4 are welcome to apply as well as solo applicants.

Education: Completed year 12 or higher

Childcare Experience: Minimum 50 hours but the more hours you have the better. This can be any fairly regular interaction with children not related to you, up to age 12.

Period of commitment: 3, 6 and 12 month placements all year round. Longer placements are available depending on the visa being extended. If you really want to go to China for 6 or 12 months but are not sure if you are ready to take the plunge and become an aupair for this period of time, you can go for 3 months. If you are comfortable with staying on, your visa can be extended.

Visa: Student Visa OR Cultural Exchange Visa: You will be advised which visa to apply for, be provided with any necessary documents and full details of how to apply once you have matched with a family. You will be provided with assistance registering with local authorities.

Applicants to China must be fluent in English without a strong accent as families wish their children to learn to speak English.

All positions are live in. All allowances and bonuses are quoted net of tax unless otherwise advised. Aupairs are not asked to drive so a driving license is not a requirement of this program.

You pay your own round trip airfare.

China

AU PAIR

- Work for 35 hours per week not more than 7 hours in one day.
- Child care and help the children practise their English and some babysitting
- Be a non smoker
- Be willing to attend Chinese language classes throughout the period of stay.
- Have a good sense of responsibility and a positive attitude

YOU GET

- Your own comfortable room, shared or own bathroom
- Full board and lodge
- 1.5 days free per week
- 1 weekend free per month
- Be given an allowance of 1200 Chinese Yuan (180AUD) per month net.
- 4 days paid vacation every 3 months.
- International travel health insurance cover provided.
- Free Chinese language lessons throughout your stay.
- At the end of your stay you will be given an airfare bonus of up to 5000 Chinese Yuan (750AUD) dependant on your length of stay.
- At the end of your stay you will be given a completion bonus of US\$250

AUPAIRS ARE PROVIDED WITH

- Airport/train pick up
- Arrival orientation
- Welcome pack with travel card and sim card
- 24 hour support helpline

China

- Monthly newsletter
- Activities with other au pairs
- Full back up and support from JCR' s associate in China with an assigned coordinator
- Full back up and support from JCR Head Office, Australia

Attendance at language classes is compulsory. Days, times and number of hours of the classes will vary depending on where the family lives that the aupair matches with.

There are 8 regions in China where aupairs may be placed with a family.

Beijing [head office] Shanghai, Chongqing, Guangzhou in Guangdong Province, Wuhan in Hubei Province, Qingdao in Shandong Province, Changsha in Hunan Province, Qunming in Yunnan province.

You are able to choose which city you would like to go to and you may request a change of family to go to a different city so as to get the most out of your Gap Year in China.

We suggest that all applicants should try to have some words of basic Chinese before they leave. Knowing some vocabulary will help you to settle in.

Whilst we have converted Yuan to \$s it is not possible to give an idea of the spending power of the Yuan in China. The allowance will be more than sufficient to socialise with young people you will meet up with and to buy personal things for yourself.

The visa to China takes about 1-2 weeks to be issued.

Apply for this country 4 months in advance of when you wish to go.

The amount paid to you is pocket money and should be accepted as that. Should you wish to travel in China while there, take additional money with you or a credit/debit card.

WHAT ARE THE COSTS

Commitment Fee:

\$200 paid to RESTLESS when completing the pre-application form

Placement Fee:

\$950 on placement with a family, paid to JCR

If your complete application reaches JCR offices by the date JCR specifies when you start an application, you will be in line for the JCR "Early Bird" discount of \$100 off the placement fee and pay only \$850.
